Our students of SBECW shared the causes and effects of Breast cancer to the village people. They insisted that Breast cancer is not a transmissible or infectious disease. Breast cancer most commonly presents as a painless lump or thickening in the breast. It is important that women finding an abnormal lump in the breast should consult a health practitioner without a delay of more than 1-2 months even when there is no pain associated with it. Seeking medical attention at the first sign of a potential symptom allows for more successful treatment. 20 NSS Volunteers and Faculty members participated in the program.
